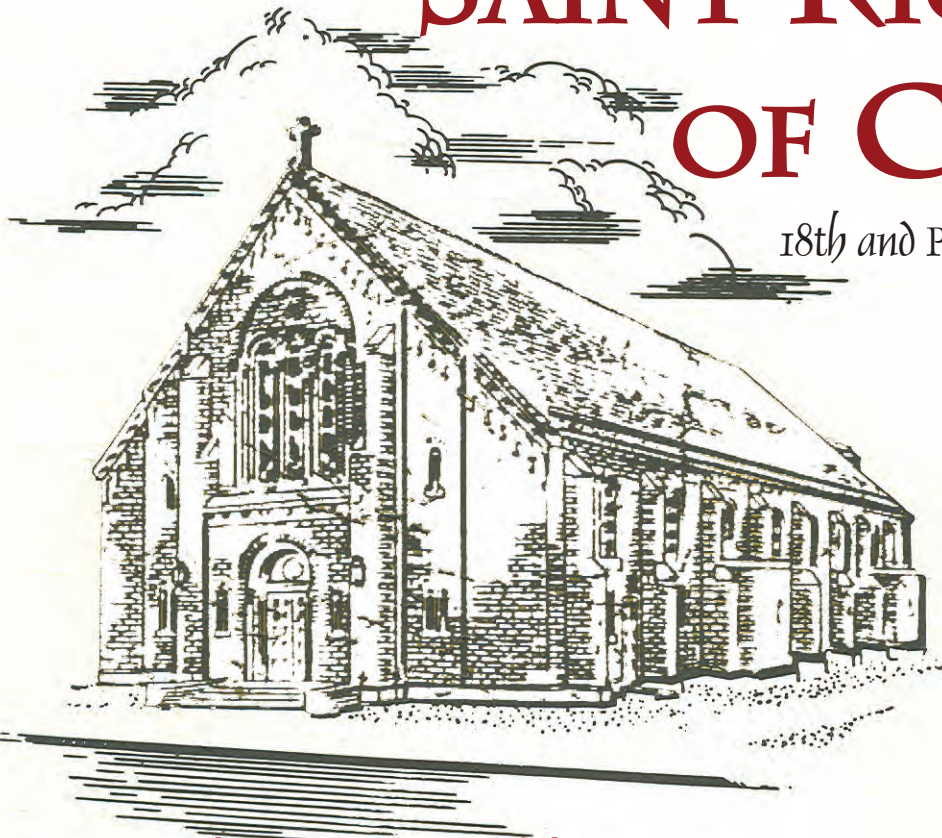

Volunteer Opportunities

We are looking to expand our CCD religious education program for the upcoming year and are seeking to fill three catechist positions for 2nd, 3rd, and 5th grade. The position is described below:

Responsibilities: The position requires an adult to prepare and teach weekly lessons to a class of 8-12 children enabling them to cultivate their Catholic Christian Faith and deepen their relationship with God. Full materials and training are provided.

Qualifications: This person must be living in accord with the Catholic faith and be open and willing to share it with others. He or she should have an ability to communicate with and manage a group of children. Classroom management and other teaching skills can be acquired through training and consultation session.

Commitment: Wednesday evenings from 6 to 7 PM, September through May with an additional one to two hours of lesson preparation at home each week. Catechists are required to take at least one ten-hour certification course each year. Course offerings (including online courses) are made available through the year the cost of which is covered by the parish.
