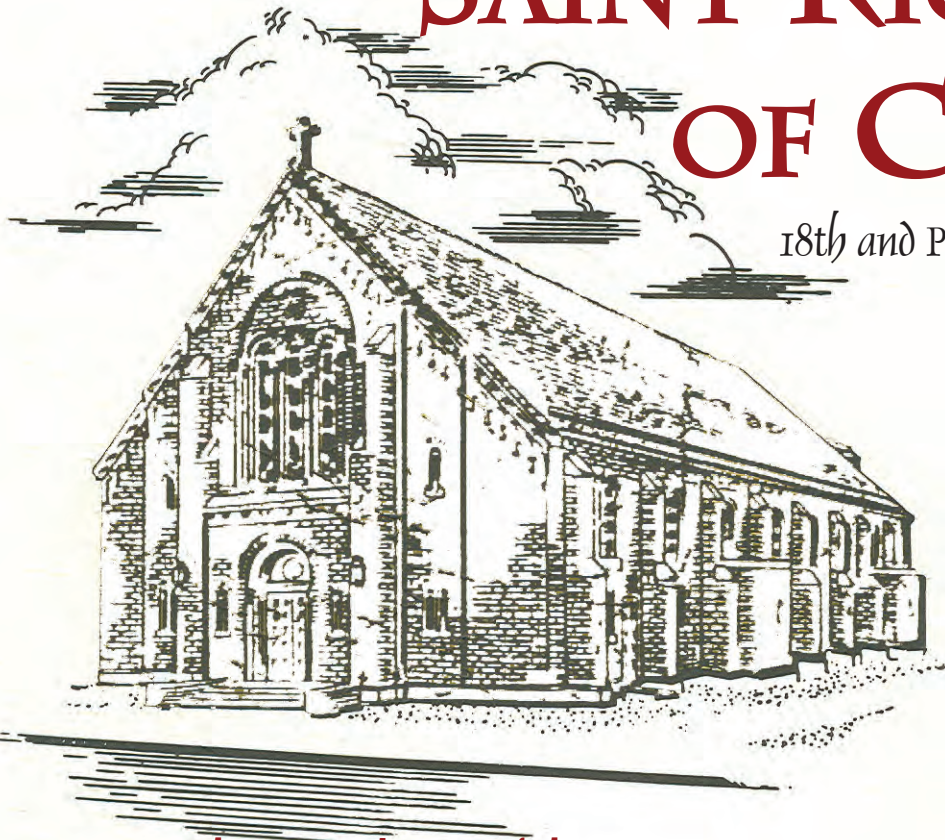

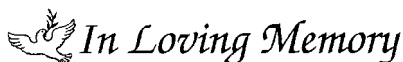
Saint Richard's Graduation Class of 1960
