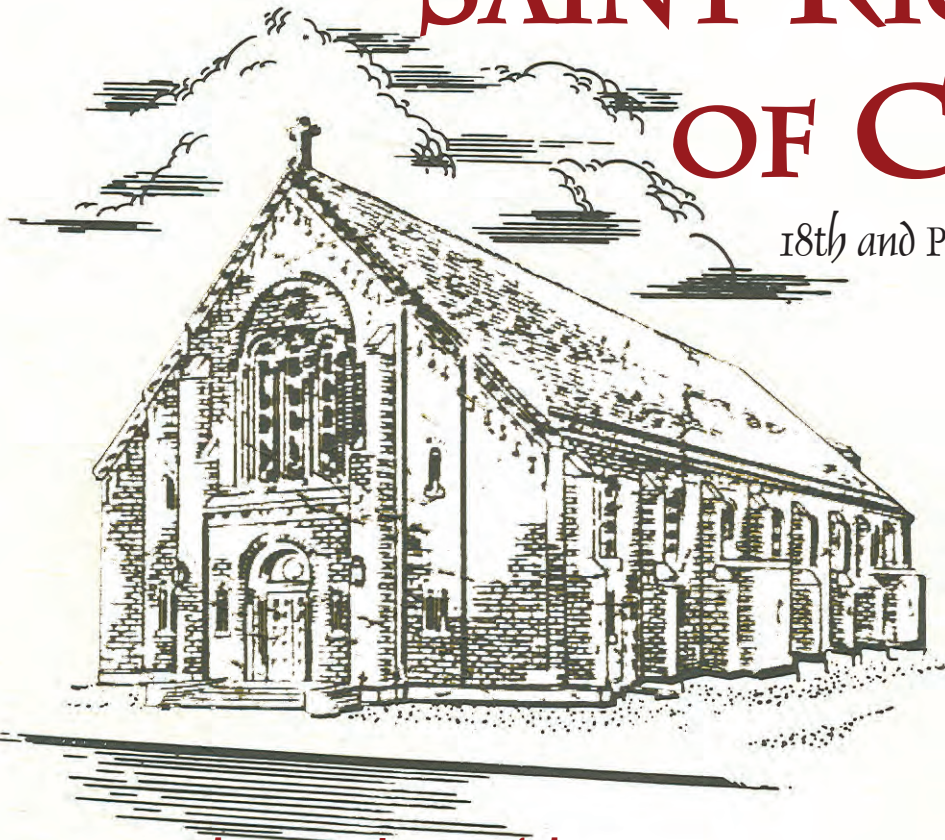

RCIA

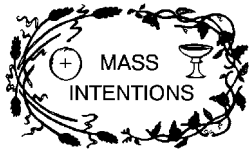
The RCIA prepares adults and adolescents for baptism and full communion in the Church. Contact the Director of Faith Formation.
