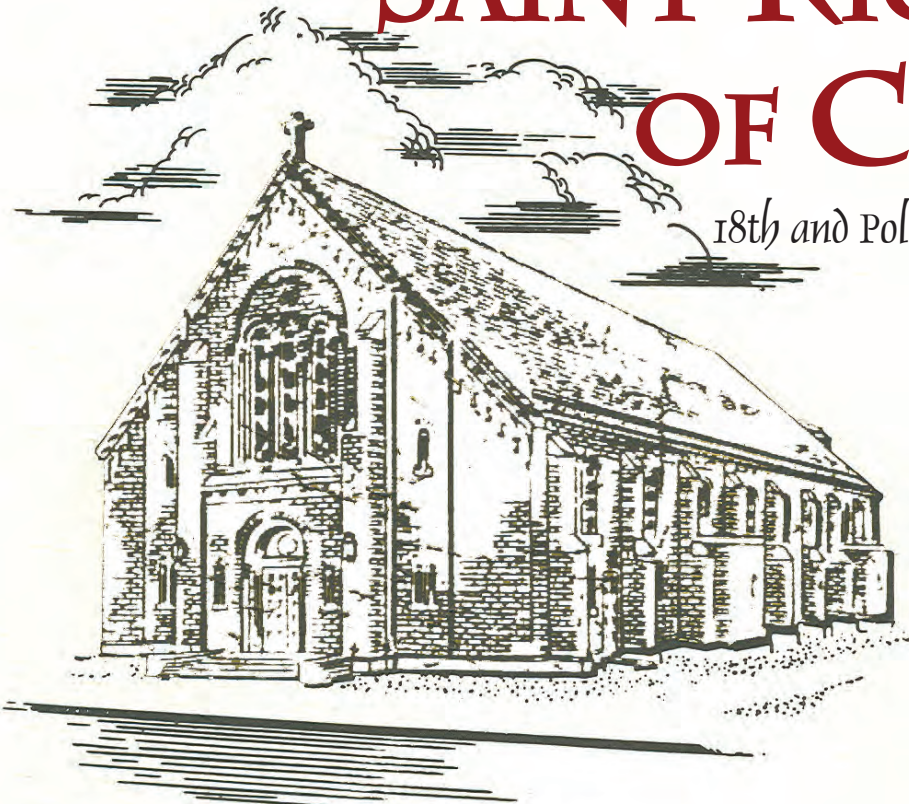

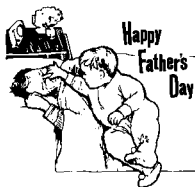

Our Holy Father, Pope Benedict XVI, has called for the whole church to celebrate an observance of the Year of the Priest. This began days ago with the celebration on Friday, June 19<sup>th</sup> of the Sacred Heart of Jesus Feast.

Our Archbishop, Cardinal Justin Rigali officially announces the **Year of the Priest** this weekend. His official announcement is published in this bulletin, following my letter.

Speaking at the 10:00 Masses these past two weekends, concerning our Archdiocesan Capital Campaign – **Heritage of Faith – Vision of Hope** was quite a challenge and made me somewhat uncomfortable. I do believe, however, this is a necessary appeal that will help our Church of Philadelphia and our parish of Saint Richard.

For now, I share these results. As of June 16<sup>th</sup>, when this bulletin goes to print, Saint Richard parish has received cash and pledges totaling \$435,459. This is certainly humbling and exciting. I am grateful for this response. This is 97% of our parish goal of \$450,000.

For those who are still praying and thinking about a pledge, please do so as soon as possible. Thank you. Thank you. Thank you.

Each year, every parish participates in the Mission Cooperation Plan. This year the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur have been assigned to our parish. This appeal will be at our Masses next weekend. The Sisters of Notre Dame De Namur serve God's poor in Nigeria, Kenya, South Africa, Zimbabwe, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Brazil, Peru, Mexico, Nicaragua as well as in Europe, the United States and Japan.

The Second Collection next weekend will be for this annual Mission Cooperation Plan. Thank you in advance for your goodness.

Be assured of my prayers and I ask for a remembrance in yours.
