PASTORAL SHARINGS

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Since Cardinal Rigali has been our Archbishop, he has assigned regional bishops to four different geographical areas of our Archdiocese. For the past five years, Auxiliary – Bishop Joseph R. Cistone has been our regional bishop. Bishop Cistone has been present here at Saint Richard parish a number of times over the past years. In April 2006 he celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation, he presided at my installation as pastor in November, 2006, he led a Holy Hour for vocations in the Lenten Season in 2007, he made a canonical visit to our school and parish in October of 2007, last year Bishop Cistone participated with our grade school children in our 40 Hours Procession.

Two months ago, Pope Benedict XVI appointed Bishop Cistone the sixth bishop of the diocese of Saginaw, Michigan. Bishop Cistone will be installed as Bishop of Saginaw this Tuesday, July 28th. Many of our priests, religious and faithful will be joining our Archbishop, Auxiliary bishops, and Bishop Cistone's family at his installation this week. This past Tuesday, July 21st, at our Cathedral of SS. Peter and Paul, the Church of Philadelphia had a celebration of Evening Prayer to extend to Bishop Cistone our prayerful thanks and support. At a reception following, I extended on our behalf the thanks, and best wishes and a personal gift from all of us at Saint Richard.

With the transfer of Bishop Cistone, the Church of Philadelphia was happy to learn that Pope Benedict XVI has appointed another of our priests, Monsignor Timothy C. Senior as auxiliary- bishop of Philadelphia. For the past five years, Monsignor Senior has been Vicar for Clergy for our Archdiocese.

This coming Friday, July 31st, in our Cathedral of SS. Peter and Paul in center City, Cardinal Rigali, along with two Co – consecrating bishops will ordain Monsignor Senior a bishop. Bishop Senior will then take up the duties and responsibilities as one of our auxiliary bishops. Bishop Senior has been assigned the regional bishop for our parish and all the parishes in Philadelphia – South, along with a few of the Delaware County Parishes.

I ask you to please offer a prayer for Bishop Cistone as he leaves Philadelphia this weekend for Saginaw, Michigan. Also, remember our new auxiliary bishop, Bishop Senior in your prayers.

Elsewhere in this bulletin is an announcement about the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). You may know someone in your family and circle of friends that may wish to become a Catholic or complete the reception of their sacraments of initiation. Ask them. It does **not** require tests or examinations that are common in school. More information can be obtained by contacting me or Mr. Dennis M. Mueller.

WHO WAS SAINT RICHARD OF CHICHESTER?

Richard was vindicated in 1247 when Henry finally released the property and funds to Richard. Richard served faithfully in his role as Bishop and vigorously defended the rights of the Church. He loved the poor and the oppressed and refrained from the finery of his office by wearing a hair shirt, and lamb's wool instead of fur. He sold his gold and silver and gave the proceeds to the poor.

Innocent the IV called upon Richard to preach a crusade against the Saracens, and Richard began the arduous journey along the coast of England preaching the crusade. He was overcome by a fever that would prove fatal, leading to his death when he reached Dover. Surrounded by his closest friends, he died at midnight on April 3, 1253 at about 56 years of age and was buried in Chichester Cathedral. His shrine was once a popular devotion until it was destroyed in 1538 under the order of Henry VIII. His remains were most likely thrown away and whatever items of worth that he was buried with were most certainly seized by the crown.

- Were baptized Catholic, but have not received First Eucharist and/or Confirmation
